RIPARO /Fondazione Pastificio Cerere, Rome, 2018

Investigating the concept of *Riparo* – which means both shelter and repairing. The exhibition imagined a new sense of community and belonging starting from *Riparo*, a prearchitectural space, a primordial form of protection, the capacity of healing and repairing. A workshop was held with students and refugees, involving clay, audio recordings, self-narration and it produced a participatory art piece: a village made of little shelters containing many voices and stories; on show also a video in a suitcase; drawings of carpets with diverse patterns and designs made with scented spices, evoking different cultures and traditions.



LA CITTA' E IL CIELO - The city and the sky/ 2018

The city and the sky is a film that tells the story of a group of men and women of different age and geographical origins, who end up among the ruins of an abandoned village, in Aspromonte, in Calabria region. They try to "dwell", repair, and recreate a sense of community. This video investigates abandoned places as not merely geographical places, but as psychological ones; in collaboration with MEDU- Doctors for Human Rights, an humanitarian organization based in south of Italy, promoting projects against exploitation of foreign laborers in agriculture.

The recurring element of salt accompained the narration as a symbol to evoke the sea as well as themes such as preserving (memory, meaning), wisdom and salary- the word sapienza and salario being rooted in the word salt in Italian.

THE END OF GEOGRAPHY/ Società Geografica Italiana, Villa Celimontana, Rome, 2015

The expression *The end of Geography,* referring to globalisation and homologation of places and culture, became a starting point, a provocation, to develop a new sense of placement and belonging based on openness and proximity, empathy and sharing, responsibility and sustainability.

My investigation has always been interested around themes of estrangment, lack of belonging and the possibility to create new forms of transient, temporary and fragile communities, based on a mobile, open and inclusive sense of identity, as a form of resistence.

This has taken the form of videos, installations, performances, photos as well as curatorial projects.




THE END OF GEOGRAPHY:

<u>DOVE COMINCIA IL LONTANO</u> Where does the faraway begin/ MAAM Museum of the otherness and of the elsewhere, Rome 2011



The community of people living in a squatted, abandoned factory, a multi ethnic group of migrants, gypsies and Italian indigent families form an heterogeneous family and are portraited on flour-sieves using spices and natural pigments.

The project involves women and children of the community in the making of bread, together with artist Guendalina Salini and curator Silvia Litardi.

A collective ritual ending up with the realization of the portraits of the inhabitants on the walls and on flour-sieves using natural pigments. This process pictures transparent and fragile identities unified around the ancient ritual of bread-making, present in each and single culture and representing an essential symbol, both sacred and common, of care and nourishment, for a human family crying for justice.

Art is here a process to cooperate in forms of resistance: active and poetic ways to contrast the impoverishment of nature, people and culture.

The bread was offered on the day of the opening to visitors..







TAPPETO DI SALE Salt Carpet /BOCS ART, COSENZA ART RESIDENCY 2015

The making of a carpet out of salt is accompanied by readings on themes of migrations and eradication, storytelling from Haitian writer Felix Morisseau Leroy, together with testimonies by Mamadoux Dai- cultural operator working with MEDU (doctors for human rights) active in south of Italy in refugee camps, with foreigners workers and migrants. The community of the old town of Cosenza was involved in cleaning and making space for the performance in an abandoned roof-less house usually filled with rubbish. Children of local schools were then invited to the performance.



A video produced during an artist residency in Puglia, titled after the novel of Cesare Pavese, composed by the stories of the old and the new inhabitants of the village: inclusion and mutual help in a moment of crisis and social change. The family-run industries extracting local limestone- pietra leccese - with which statues of saints and architectures were made, are now faced with a reorganization of production and economy, thanks also to new workers coming from Africa.

Participatory art work including collecting textiles, tint them with local plants, sewing them together to create a colorful table cloth and offering a picnic to the local community in the museum outdoors
























LA MIA PATRIA E' UN FILO D'ERBA CHE TREMA

become precious and the subject for a new narrative, giving value to everyday people in their territory.










The photos are then exhibited in big format around the villages.
